



Emblem of choice – Persuasive text – Task

Your classroom OR school need a new emblem – symbol. It's your job to choose a native Western Australian plant or animal to be that new emblem. You will need to brainstorm native plants and animals and select the one you think best represents your classroom or school and why. Then you will need to convince your principal yours is the best choice. Time to use your new persuasive writing skills! Write a short, three paragraph, persuasive text justifying your choice. Good luck!

You need to:

- Brainstorm native Western Australian plants and animals (flora and fauna) for a potential emblem for your classroom OR school
- Select ONE plant or animal
- Do some research about your chosen plant or animal and create a set of notes about your choice. Remember, you need to find key information to justify your choice
- Use your knowledge of persuasive language and texts to create a short persuasive text convincing your principal that yours if the best choice
- Proofread and edit your final draft to create your completed persuasive text.

Remember, your persuasive text should:

- Include key information about your chosen plant or animal
- Demonstrate your understanding of persuasive language and texts
- Convince your principal of your choice (Remember: purpose and intended audience)
- Be only three paragraphs long
- Be interesting and informative!
