SEARCH FOR WA'S TOP ACHIEVERS LAUNCHED

Nominations are now open for the 2014 Western Australian of the Year Awards.

Announced today at Brookfield Place, the awards recognise the highest level of contribution made to Western Australia by those either born in WA, or those who have chosen to call WA home.

The Awards are organised by not-for-profit organisation Celebrate WA, which has the responsibility for promoting and organising the annual WA Day celebrations.

The Awards launch coincided with the announcement of the appointment to the Celebrate WA Board of Tonya McCusker, wife of the Western Australian Governor Malcolm McCusker AC CVO QC (see separate media release).

Award nominations are open to any member of the Western Australian community and the awards are presented at a gala ceremony that will mark the start of the WA Day long weekend on 30 May this year.

Nominations close on the 14th March, with winners announced at a Gala Dinner to be held on Friday 30 May 2014 at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.

The overall Western Australian of the Year is selected from the winners of the individual categories.
