LAST CHANCE TO NOMINATE OUTSTANDING LOCALS FOR WA'S TOP AWARDS

Time is rapidly running out to nominate extraordinary Western Australians for the first Western Australian of the Year Awards of the decade, with online nominations closing Friday, 28 February.

The Awards give every Western Australian the opportunity to acknowledge someone in their community doing outstanding work, and to celebrate the diversity and excellence in our State.

There are seven Award categories:

- Arts & Culture Award sponsored by Woodside Energy

- Sport Award sponsored by Channel Seven

The online nomination process can be completed at waday.com, and simply requires people to select a category for their nominee, describe the nominee's achievements and their impact on our community. Any person born in WA or who has made Western Australia their home is eligible for nomination.

The finalists will be announced in April, with the category winners and overall Western Australian of the Year announced on Friday, 29 May at a Gala Dinner at Crown Ballroom. The event marks the start of the WA Day long weekend, which is celebrated with events across the State.

Celebrate WA Chair, Michael Anghie, encouraged the public to nominate someone in their field or community who deserved to be recognised for their achievements.
